Association Member

Role Description and Expectations

Purpose: To promote, play at discount, volunteer, and vote in association directors in accordance with the organizations mission and needs.

TCTTA Mission statement: to provide a place for table tennis players to experience, improve, and advance the sport to every generation and skill level.

***Major responsibilities:**

- Helping to setup and take down club equipment
- Practicing hospitality toward guests
- Inviting new people to play and encouraging them to become members
- Receiving a 50% discount on play and league
- Volunteering for a support role (web, social networking, etc.)
- Suggesting ways that will enhance the association and invite more players.
- Nominating and confirming the Board of Directors who lead the clubs policies, finances and procedures.

Length of term: Annually Jan 1 – Dec 31 in the Calendar year once membership dues are paid.

Meetings and time commitment:

- An association member can attend as little or as much as their schedule allows. We appreciate those who take ownership of the club by attending as frequently as possible and helping to setup and take down equipment.
- An association member can attend any Director Board meetings, typically they meet 1-3 times each year and last 30-60 minutes.
- An association member should consider being a USATT member also and participate in regional tournaments.

Expectations of Association Members:

- Positive attitude and hospitality.
- Address issues of concern to Board Members via email or face to face in a constructive and respectful way.
- Help setup and take down equipment.
- Communicate and interact using Social Networks (Facebook) and Email.
- Be alert to community concerns that can be addressed by the TCTTA mission, objectives, and programs.
- Help communicate and promote TCTTA mission and events to the community.
- Read Annual/Bi-Annual report on clubs Director decisions, budget, and initiatives.
- Follow the posted TCTTA rules and etiquette for play.
